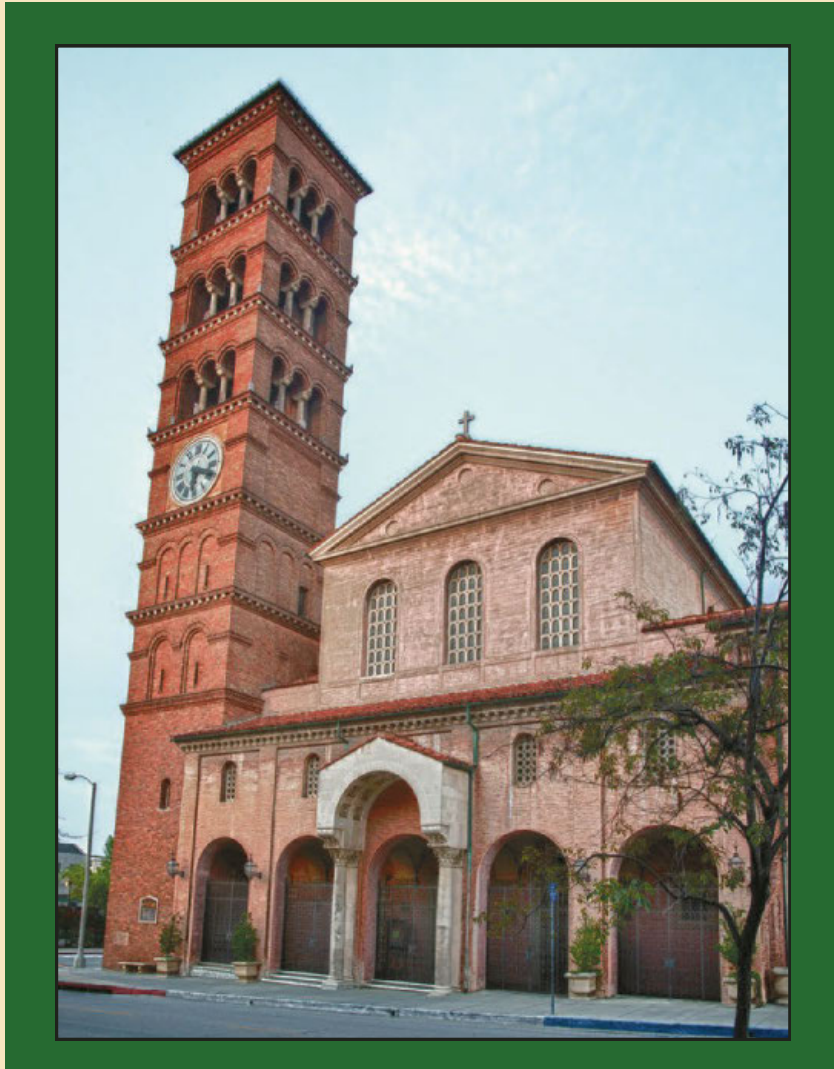

- We would have your email address in order to receive the parish emails. I send emails to all registered parishioners each week with important information about activities in the parish.

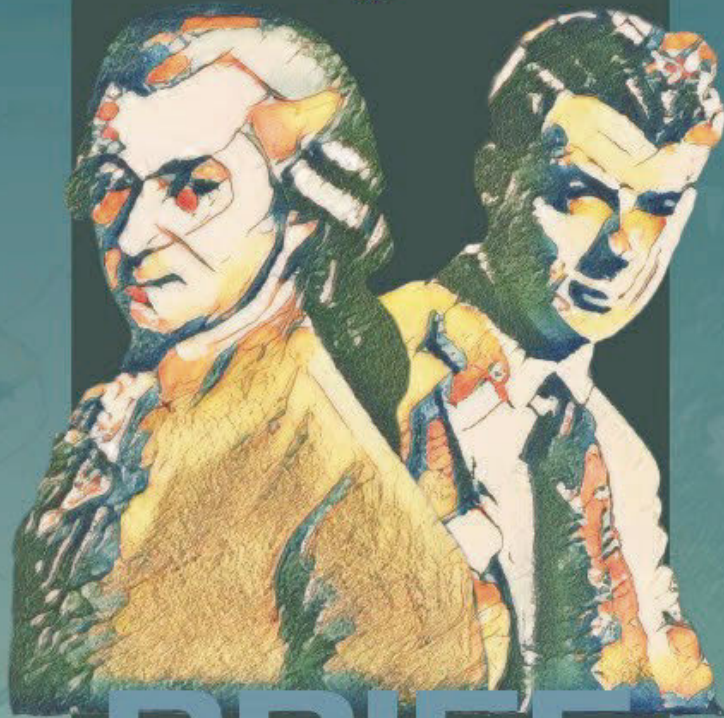

## FROM THE MUSIC DIRECTOR THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD MAY 12, 2024

### INTROIT

*Viri Galilæi, quid admiramini aspicientes in cælum? alleluia: quemadmodum vidistis eum ascendentem in cælum, ita veniet, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.*

Ps. *Omnes gentes plaudite manibus: iubilate Deo in voce exsultationis.*

*Men of Galilee, why do you look to the skies? Alleluia: he whom you have seen ascending into heaven, he will come again, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.*

Psalm verse: *All you nations, clap your hands: rejoice in God with a voice of exultation.*

### THE LITURGICAL YEAR

The solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord is traditionally celebrated on the Thursday nine days before Pentecost Sunday, in commemoration of the nine days' wait of the apostles before the descent of the Holy Spirit. This, incidentally, was the first novena. In the western United States, the solemnity of the Ascension has been transferred to the seventh Sunday of Easter, and so we celebrate today what would have, traditionally, been celebrated last Thursday.

The readings for today's celebration coordinate particularly closely, each of the four readings (and we include the responsorial psalm in this count) illuminating a different aspect of the mystery. Nearly uniquely, we have two accounts, one from *Acts of the Apostles* and one from the Gospel of Mark. In the reading from *Acts*, the coming of the Holy Spirit is emphasized, while in the Gospel reading, the Great Commission is given: to go and preach the Gospel to all creatures, to baptize them, and to lay hands on them that they may be healed.

### MUSIC IN THE LITURGY

In our continuing examination of the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, we come now to the paragraphs that deal with the importance of singing in the Mass. We are reminded how the earliest Christians, when they gathered in liturgical *synaxis* (assembly), they sang Psalms, hymns, and spiritual canticles (cf. Colossians 3:16); that singing is the sign of the heart's joy (see Acts 2:46) and therefore the great doctor of the Church St. Agustin could rightfully say "Singing is for one who loves." We are also reminded of the ancient proverb, often attributed to St. Augustin, that "One who sings *well* prays twice." It is important to note that: who sings *well* prays twice. What does that mean?

To sing *well* means to sing to the best of one's ability. It means to sing with devotion of the heart, with full intent and intention of the mind, and to sing with the greatest skill one has. For the members of the congregation, it means to sing as well as one might, with fervent and devout mind and heart, for it belongs to them, as members of a "chosen race, a royal priesthood" to make offerings by singing the responses of the Mass, to offer their prayers, and to intercede for the world before God. For those who are in the choir, a special lay ministry of the congregation, who serve in place of the clerics who once filled that role, it is additionally their role to sing well in a *musical* manner.

What is *musical singing*? It is singing with voices that are clear and trained, that are particularly well-skilled (through often years of practice) so that the choir may assist the rest of the assembly with its prayers. Recall the Vatican II instruction *Musicam Sacram* tells us, in paragraph 15b: "The faithful should also be taught to unite themselves interiorly to what the ministers or choir sing, so that by listening to them they may raise their minds to God." The higher the skill level of the choir, the more effective its ministry.

Next week, we will continue examining the *General Instruction* and what it has to say about the role of music. We will examine paragraph 40 and 41. ## DEL DIRECTOR DE MUSICA

Ascensión del Señor  
12 de mayo de 2024

### INTROITO

### EL AÑO LITÚRGICO

La solemnidad de la Ascensión de Nuestro Señor se celebra tradicionalmente el jueves nueve días antes del domingo de Pentecostés, en conmemoración de los nueve días de espera de los apóstoles antes de la venida del Espíritu Santo. Ésta, dicho sea de paso, fue la primera novena. En el oeste de los Estados Unidos, la solemnidad de la Ascensión se ha trasladado al séptimo domingo de Pascua, por lo que hoy celebramos lo que tradicionalmente se habría celebrado el jueves pasado.

Las lecturas para la celebración de hoy coordinan particularmente estrechamente, cada una de las cuatro lecturas (e incluimos el salmo responsorial en este recuento) ilumina un aspecto diferente del misterio. Casi únicamente tenemos dos relatos, uno de los *Hechos de los Apóstoles* y otro del Evangelio de Marcos. En la lectura de los *Hechos* se enfatiza la venida del Espíritu Santo, mientras que en la lectura del Evangelio se da la Gran Comisión: ir y predicar el Evangelio a todas las criaturas, bautizarlas e imponerles manos para que puedan ser curado.

### MÚSICA EN LA LITURGIA

En nuestro examen continuo de la Instrucción *General del Misal Romano*, llegamos ahora a los párrafos que tratan de la importancia del canto en la Misa. Se nos recuerda cómo los primeros cristianos, cuando se reunían en *sinaxis* litúrgica (asamblea), cantaban Salmos, himnos y cánticos espirituales (cf. Colosenses 3:16); que el canto es signo de la alegría del corazón (ver Hechos 2:46) y por eso el gran doctor de la Iglesia San Agustín podría decir con razón “El canto es para quien ama”. También nos recuerda el antiguo proverbio, a menudo atribuido a San Agustín, que dice que “Quien canta *bien*, ora dos veces”. Es importante señalar que: quien canta *bien* ora dos veces. ¿Qué significa eso?

Cantar *bien* significa cantar lo mejor que uno pueda. Significa cantar con devoción del corazón, con plena intención e intención de la mente, y cantar con la mayor habilidad que uno tenga. Para los miembros de la congregación, significa cantar lo mejor que se pueda, con mente y corazón ferviente y devoto, porque a ellos les corresponde, como miembros de una “linaje escogido, un sacerdocio real” hacer ofrendas cantando las respuestas de la Misa, ofrecer sus oraciones e interceder por el mundo ante Dios. Para aquellos que están en el coro, un ministerio laico especial de la congregación, que sirven en lugar de los clérigos que alguna vez desempeñaron ese papel, es además su papel cantar bien de manera *musical*.

¿Qué es el *canto musical*? Es cantar con voces claras y entrenadas, especialmente hábiles (a menudo a través de años de práctica) para que el coro pueda ayudar al resto de la asamblea con sus oraciones. Recordemos la instrucción del Vaticano II que nos dice *Musicam Sacram*, en el párrafo 15b: “Se debe enseñar también a los fieles a unirse interiormente a lo que cantan los ministros o el coro, para que, escuchándolos, puedan elevar su mente a Dios”. Cuanto mayor sea el nivel de habilidad del coro, más eficaz será su ministerio.

La próxima semana seguiremos examinando la *Instrucción General* y lo que tiene que decir sobre el papel de la música. Examinaremos los párrafos 40 y 41.
